
National Diabetes Prevention Pathway – Referral Pathway Diagram



'High Risk of Diabetes' Register Patients who require annual HbA1c testing.

- 1. Patients with the following diagnosis are to be added:
- Severe Mental Health Disorders
- Learning Difficulties
- Chronic Pancreatitis
- History of Gestational Diabetes
- PCOS (Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome)
- 2. Patients who have had the following results at any time are to be added:
- HbA1c 42 47 mmol/mml
- FPG 5.5 6.9 mmol/mml
 - 3. Patients who have this diagnosis time should be added at clinical discretion
- IGT
- IFG

Ethnicity Screening

Patients who are of the following ethnicity have a heightened risk of developing diabetes before the age of 40

> South Asian Chinese African-Caribbean Black African

The patients should be assessed via the diabetes.uk risk assessment tool and a decision made as to whether they should be added to the register.
