Booking my X-ray What should I do next?

This sheet has been produced to give you general information about your x-ray. It is not meant to replace the discussion between you and your doctor, but may act as a starting point for discussion. If after reading it you have any concerns or require further explanation, please discuss this with a member of the healthcare team who has been caring for you.

How do I book my x-ray?

Please telephone the appointment centre between

8:30am and 4:30pm-Monday to Friday

When you telephone, please have available the x-ray request form given to you by your GP.

The appointment centre will ask you to confirm details from the form about yourself, your GP and the examination required.

You can then agree an appointment time, date and hospital that is best for you.

If you are unable to attend, please notify us as soon as possible so that we can offer you an alternative date. If you fail to keep your appointment without letting us know in advance, you will be discharged and your GP will be informed.

How do I obtain the results of my x-ray?

Your x-ray will be sent to a Consultant Radiologist who will provide a report. This report will then be forwarded to your GP within approximately 7 to 14 days.

A copy of the report is also available for your GP to view on the GP browser system.

You will need to make contact with your GP to obtain the results.
